IAR – CCIM	The Integrated Assessment Record is a repository for standardized community assessments accessible to health service providers. CCIM assessment projects enable patient-centred care by ensuring that providers are able to communicate through a common language in the form of standardized assessments.	RM&R	Resource Matching and Referral Business Transformation Initiative which began as a way to help streamline the complex patient referral system across Ontario. In scope care pathways defined as: Acute to Rehab Acute to Complex Continuing Care Acute to Long-Term Care Acute to CCAC In-Home services Within NE LHIN expanded to: Community Support Services Community Mental Health and Addictions.
CCT	Care Coordination Tool enables a standardized care plan that Health Links providers can create, maintain and shared electronically. Sharing enabled by IAR infrastructure and privacy framework.		
POI	Physician Office Integration is an electronic hospital reporting system ensuring that primary care providers receive complete and timely hospital discharge summaries and other hospital reports for their patients.	eNEO	The regional Hubs will deliver key ehealth services to their respective regions including a Regional Portal rendering key local health information (ie. hospitals) and provincial data (ie. OLIS); a Clinical Data Repository collecting & rendering key health documents (ie. discharge reports); and regional integration to simplify the connection of health information systems in the regions.
CHRIS /HPG	Health Portal Gateway (HPG) is a portal application that supports the exchange and sharing of client information between health partners in a secure and timely manner. Allows for view of CCAC specific client information for coordination of care.	OTN	Telemedicine via Videoconferencing (room-based or PC) increases access to care. Includes suite of OTN applications: Teledermatology, Telestroke, Teletrauma, Teleburn, Teleophthamology. StoreForward for dermatology, wound care, psychiatry, ophthalmology.
ONE Mail	Secure email solution allowing exchange of Personal Health Information between health service providers.	Pt Order Set	Electronic evidence-based patient order sets are research based checklists that allow physicians, nurses and other healthcare professionals to specify appropriate treatments for their patients.
OLIS	The Ontario Laboratories Information System is a provincial repository of lab test results; includes coverage of 96% of community lab tests.	THC	Telehomecare uses remote monitoring equipment and a nurse-coaching model to help COPD and Heart Failure patients become better self-managers of their health .
DPV	Drug Profile Viewer is a provincial viewer of ODB – Ontario Drug Benefits	NEON	Common hospital information system for 22 hospitals in the NE LHIN.
NEODIN	The Digital Imaging program includes regional repositories and services providing clinicians with access to diagnostic images.	IDS - BI	Integrated Decision Support Business Intelligence tool to facilitate the automated identification of the high needs complex patient activity and flag partners engaged in collaborative care planning. Allows health service providers to gain important insights into their patients' journeys for specific populations and indicators and allows for improved collaboration and outcomes.
ONE Portal	Provincial web portal offering secure access to select eHealth Ontario applications. Also supports Health Link community sites/collaboration spaces.	eConsult	eConsult allows primary care providers to electronically send a question to a specialist prior to patient referral.
eNotification	Notifies the NE CCAC when a patient is admitted to hospital and notifies hospitals that a patient is receiving home care services. Plans to expand notification to primary care providers EMRs. (includes ED, admission, discharges)	eCHN	eCHN is a paediatric electronic health record (EHR) that shares patients' clinical data primarily hospital records, including admission/discharge information, clinic notes, diagnostic imaging reports, lab test results and referrals.
