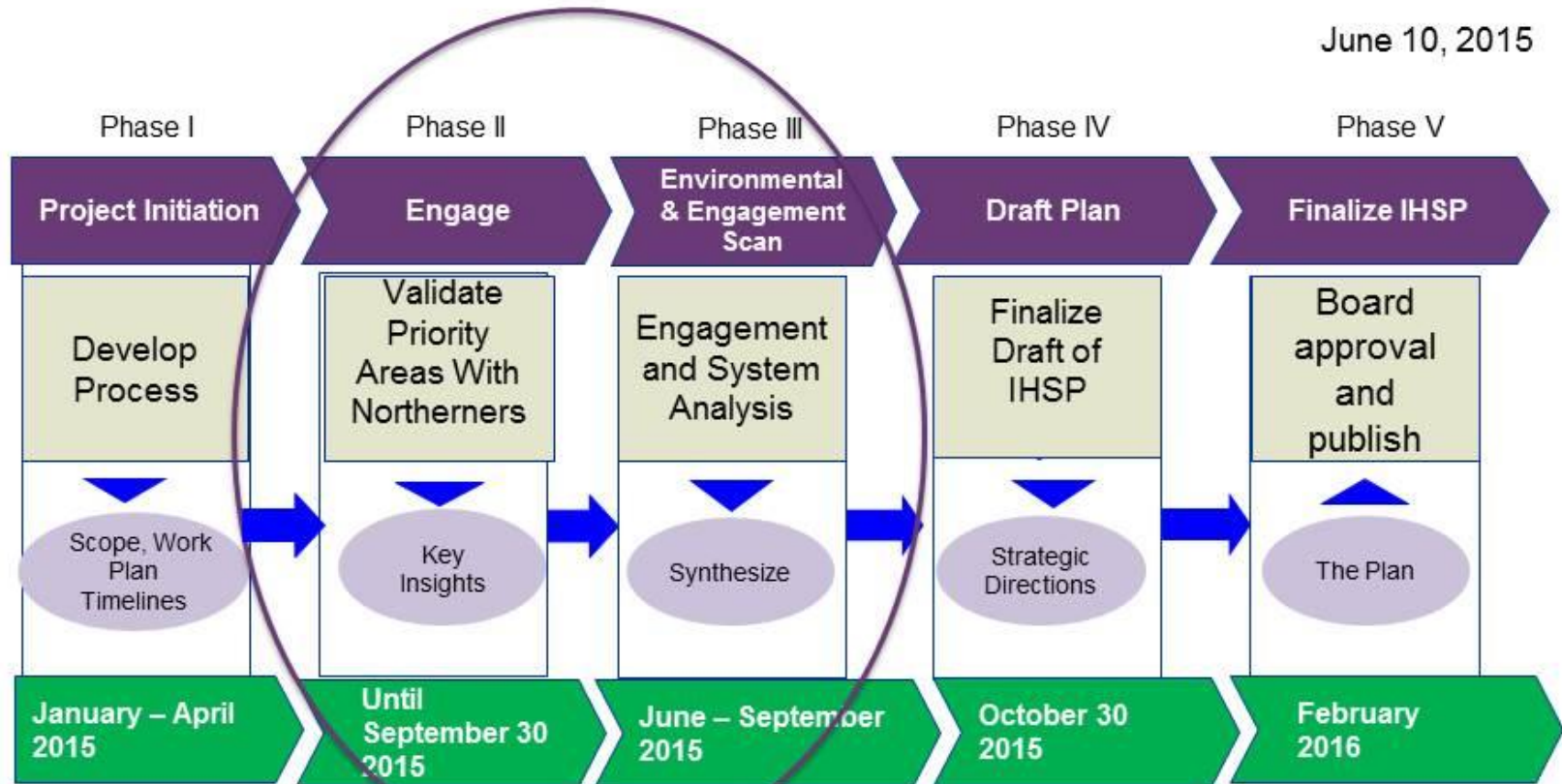

 - Ongoing engagements with health service providers and advisory, steering committees and work groups
