Job Summary

The Diabetes Educator (Registered Nurse) collaborates with the interdisciplinary team to provide assessment, individual and group counseling, health education, and case management related to self-management of diabetes for VON clients. The Diabetes Educator (Registered Nurse) will work with clients and their caregivers to achieve the most appropriate level of chronic disease self-management possible.

Responsibilities

- Conducts assessments that incorporate professional judgment in determining client strengths, areas of growth and appropriate interventions to achieve successful, long-term management of diabetes symptoms.
- Engages clients in goal development and monitors outcomes through on-going assessment and documentation of treatment progress with clear notes (on electronic medical records (EMR) if available).
- Provides supportive counseling by utilizing various treatment approaches to enhance client awareness, motivation, and self-regulation.
- Provides advocacy to enhance clients' social determinants of health as needed
- Performs community outreach visits/programs as needed
- Maintains communication with clients to follow-up on concerns and/or referrals
- Utilizes appropriate interviewing and communication skills to obtain information from the client/family/caregiver
- Participates in case conferences with the interdisciplinary team and external service providers as needed

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing is required
- Certified Diabetes Educator preferred
- Certified Pump Trainer preferred
- Experience in pediatric diabetes and chronic disease management preferred
- Knowledge of chronic disease self-management approach
- Experience working as a member of a multi-disciplinary team
- Evidence of professional liability insurance
- Current CPR Certification
- Current criminal background check
